Students must have either TOEFL iBT® 45-46, TOEIC® 550, IELTS 4.5 overall (with writing 4.5), completed SSLC ESL-SF Level 3 or ESL-SC Level 6, any recognized international English language equivalency test score, or a pass on our Entrance Exam. Interview and essay required.

EXIT REQUIREMENTS

Program exit level is an overall average of 80% in course work. If a student fails to meet these requirements, they can take an additional month in an attempt to achieve the required grade.
